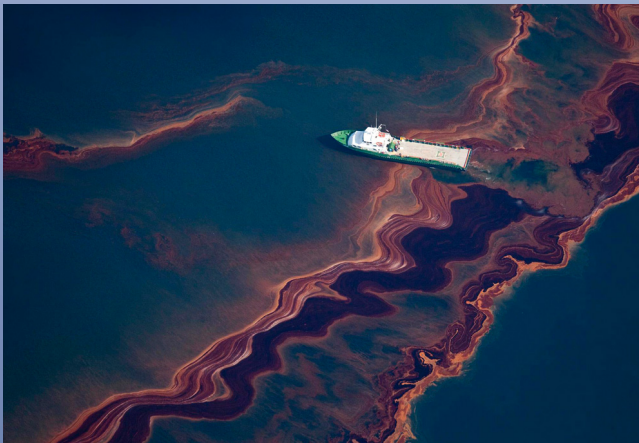


The Clean Energy Gulf Challenge: *Inspire America to Kick Her Dangerous Oil Addiction*



Organizations, research institutions and individuals are invited to submit their plans that include a detailed policy and technology discussion explaining how America can end domestic oil production in the Gulf of Mexico and oil imports from the Persian Gulf. This requires the U.S. to displace approximately 20% of its consumption of oil by 2020. A panel of judges will review entries and choose the top three proposals among those received by noon on Monday, June 14th. After a series of public webinars, the public can cast votes during the week of July 4th with a winner announced on Tuesday July, 13th.

The *Clean Energy Gulf Challenge* is a \$10,000 prize contest seeking the most visionary plan in the quest to end America's dependence on "Gulf" oil: both offshore drilling and production in the Gulf of Mexico and oil imports from the Persian Gulf. The winning plan will be the most innovative vision, grounded in solid policy and practical technological opportunities, to guide us towards more secure and sustainable clean energy solutions.
